4) WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW TO CREATE YOUR FIRST SEARCH

- Find your passage first in the syntax graph
- Start at the word level and build
- Check 'Matching Skips Levels'
- Turn on Highlighting
- Search only the range of your example until you get a match in the search result

5) REDUCE YOUR SEARCH RESULTS WITH SYNTAX

➤ Reducing your search results

- Understanding boundaries (word, phrase, sentence, paragraph, etc)

Bible Concordance Search

➤ Word(s) Search (135 Results) - love of God

James 2:5 Listen, my beloved brethren: did not **God** choose the poor **of** this world to be rich in faith and heirs **of** the kingdom which He promised to those who **love** Him?

➤ Phrase(s) Search (11 Results) "love of God"

Romans 8:39 nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the **love of God**, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

5) REDUCE YOUR SEARCH RESULTS WITH SYNTAX

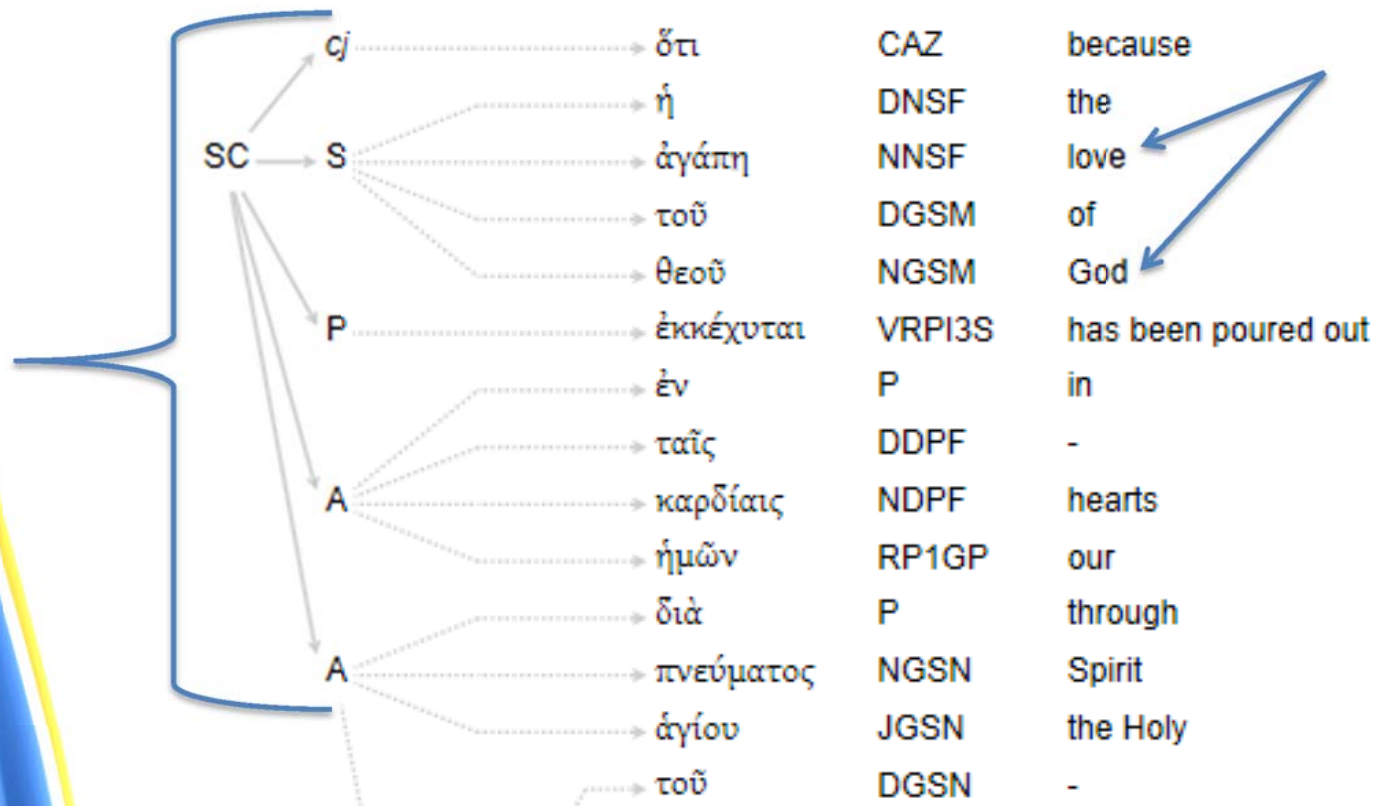
➤ Morphological Search

- Word or Phrase + morphological information
- Search > Bible > “love of God” > Analysis > Result & Case
- Note: Love verb or noun? Is the subject or object of the sentence?
- Examples
- “love of God” as the accusative/Direct Object (whom or what)
 - Luke 11:42
 - lemma:ἀγάπη@NASF AND lemma:ὁ@NGSM AND lemma:θεός@NGSM
- “love (agape) of God” as the subject of the sentence
“Nominative”/Subject
 - lemma:ἀγάπη@NNSF AND lemma:ὁ@NGSM AND lemma:θεός@NGSM
 - Romans 5:5

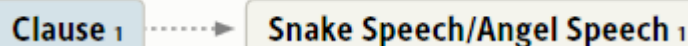


6) WHO IS BEING SPOKEN TO? ADDRESSEE SEARCH

 - Snake/Satan Speech – Look at Semantics in Segment



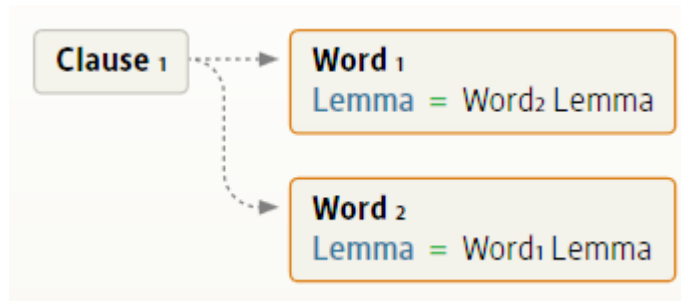
7) WORKING W/ SEMANTIC DOMAINS / GENERAL IDEAS

- Mark 1:23 Supernatural Beings / Devil

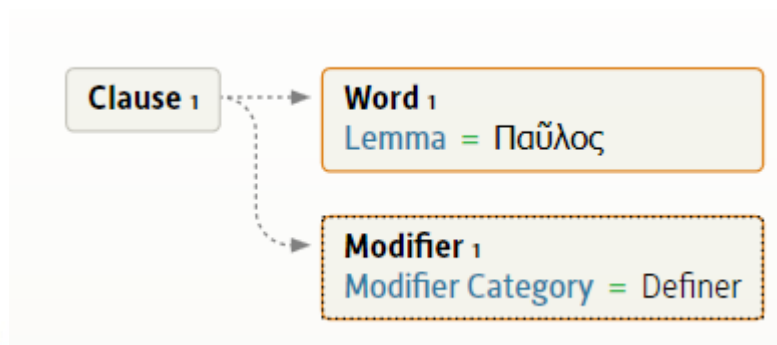

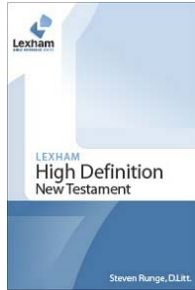
